Project Overview

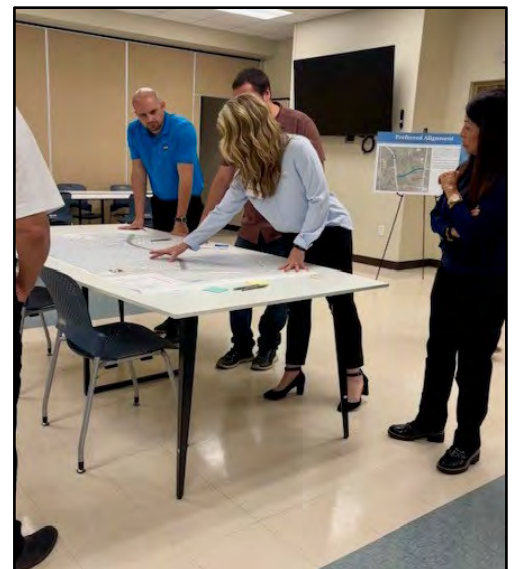
Hays County is advancing plans to extend William Pettus Rd from SH 21 to FM 110 to enhance east-west mobility and support the region's continued growth. This proposed roadway connection aims to enhance mobility and help manage traffic in one of Central Texas's fastest-growing areas, including San Marcos and Kyle.

Open House Summary

Hays County hosted a public Open House on Thursday, Nov. 6, 2025, at The Hays County Transportation Department (2171 Yarrington Rd, San Marcos, TX 78666). Materials shared at the Open House were also made available online at williampettusroad.com. The open comment period was available from Thursday, Nov. 6 through Friday, Nov. 21, 2025.

The purpose of this open house was to share information on the William Pettus Road Extension project and collect input from the community. A comment form was available at the in-person open house and online for participants to share their comments and ask questions. A roll plot of the preferred alignment was available at the in person open house and online for participants to share feedback to the project team.

Approximately 15 individuals, including Commissioner Debbie Ingalsbe, attended the open house. The project website received 52 views during the comment period.

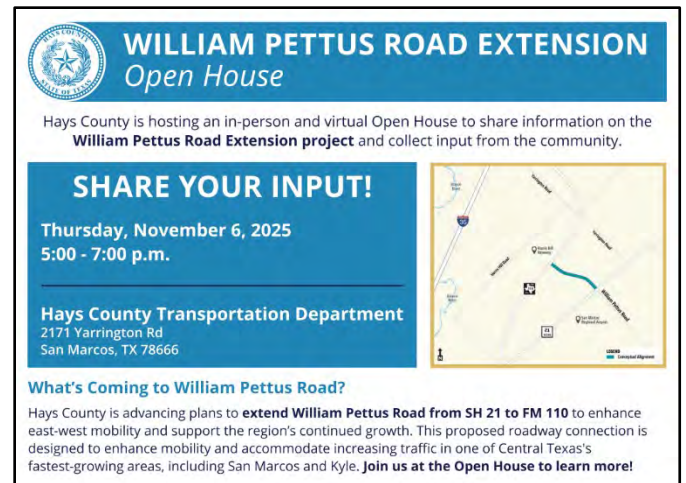


Open House Notification Tools

Postcard - Postcards were mailed to 52 property owners throughout the project limits on Oct. 23, 2025.

Email Notices - The project team emailed two meeting notices to 56 stakeholders on Oct. 30 and Nov. 6. The project team also emailed a comment period reminder to 56 stakeholders on Nov. 19 before the comment period closed.

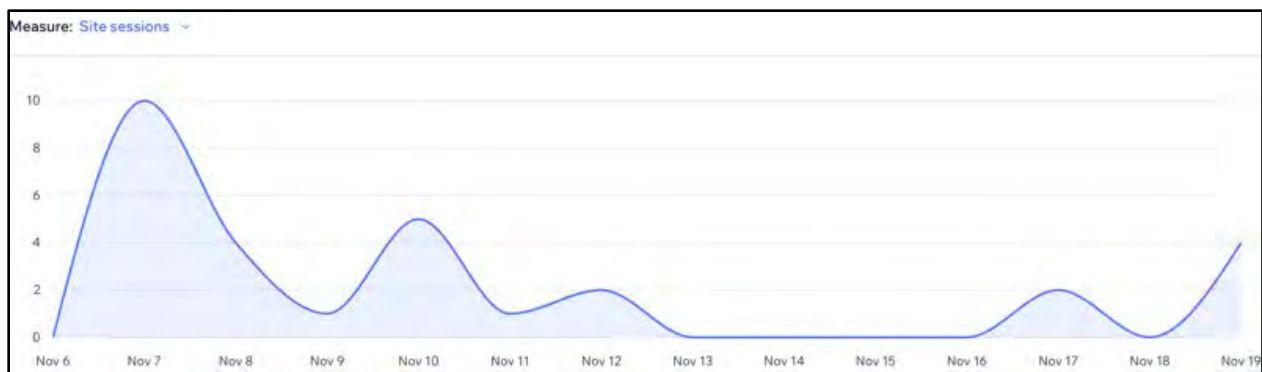

The project team also engaged with in-person open house attendees about the project status, preferred alignment and next steps. As well as answer any questions related to future phases of the project such as construction or right-of-way (ROW).

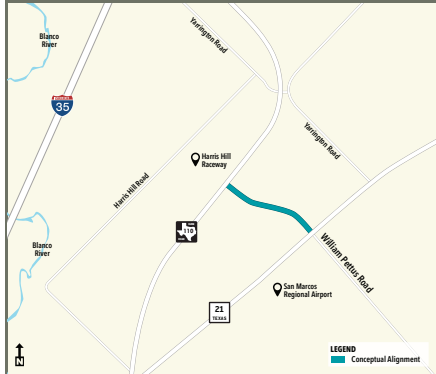

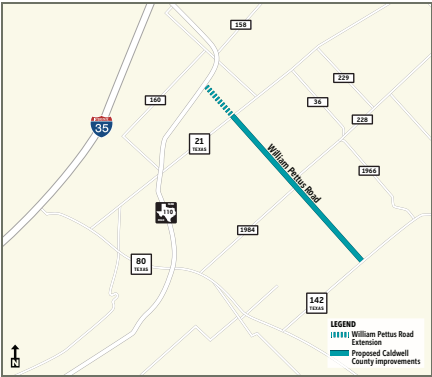
Project Introduction



- Why This Project?**
- Enhance east-west connectivity
 - Improves safety and mobility
 - Reduce traffic congestion
 - Support local growth in one of Central Texas' fastest-growing areas, including San Marcos and Kyle.



Project Background



Extending William Pettus Road was first identified as a priority in Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization's (CAMPO) Western Caldwell County Transportation Study. This study analyzed factors like:

- Current and future traffic patterns
- Economic growth
- Environmental considerations
- Population growth

One of the key recommendations from the study was to create a new connection between SH 21 and FM 110 to improve access and reduce congestion on surrounding roadways.



Alignment Options



- Route Scenarios**
- The project team conducted an alignment study, evaluating multiple route options to consider:
- Property owner input
 - Safety
 - Environmental impacts
 - Cost
- This study led to a proposed alignment for public consideration that would provide:
- The best safety and mobility improvements
 - Minimized impacts to property owners
 - The best intersection spacing to the existing FM 110/Yarrington Road intersection



Preferred Alignment



The preferred alignment, or **Alignment C**, was chosen because it best meets project goals while minimizing negative community impacts. This option provides:

- Improved safety and mobility
- Minimized impacts to property owners
- Optimal intersection spacing at the FM 110/Yarrington Road intersection

Next Steps

Hays County and the project team will continue to develop the schematic design while refining cost estimates and designs. The next steps will involve close collaboration with stakeholders, including property owners, local government agencies, and TxDOT.



Current project funding supports corridor planning, design, right-of-way acquisition and environmental coordination. Additional funding sources for construction are currently being evaluated.
