

Fitzhugh Road Safety Study Public Involvement Summary

Project Overview

Hays County is planning for preliminary safety improvements along Fitzhugh Road from RM 12 to the Hays County line. A safety study was conducted in spring 2024 to identify near term mobility and safety improvements that could be made within the existing County right-of-way. The study included traffic counts, speed monitoring, signage and pavement analysis, and a review of crash data.



Property Owner Meetings

Hays County hosted individual meetings with property owners where additional right of way is proposed for interim improvements. The goal of the property owner meetings was to inform impacted property owners about the goals of the project and discuss property impacts and design considerations.

Meeting invites were mailed to five properties and the project team met with three of the five impacted property owners.

Open House Summary

Hays County hosted an Open House on Wednesday, Oct. 9, 2024, at Dripping Springs Ranch Park (1042 Event Center Dr., Dripping Springs, TX 78620). Materials shared at the Open House were available online at fitzhughsafetystudy.com and a comment period was available from Wednesday, Oct. 9 through Friday, Oct. 25, 2024.

The purpose of the meeting was to share project information and information on the proposed safety improvements to Fitzhugh Road from RM 12 to the Hays County line. A general comment form was available at the Open House and online for participants to ask questions and share their comments and a roll plot of the project limits was available at the Open House for participants to share property specific comments.



Participants at the Open House

Approximately 16 individuals including Commissioner Walt Smith attended the Open House and the project website received 125 views during the comment period. The project team received 17 comments during the comment period.

Open House Notification Tools

Postcard – Postcards were mailed to 121 property owners throughout the project limits on Sept. 26, 2024.

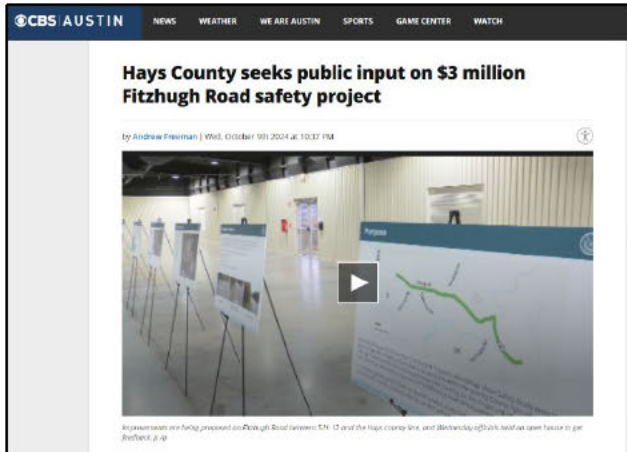
Email Notices – Three email notices were mailed to 63 stakeholders on Sept. 26, Oct. 8, and Oct. 24, 2024.

What We Heard

Open House comments were shared through several different means including mapped comments, online comment form, and in-person comment responses. The Open House received a total of 17 comments and the key themes are identified below.

Key Themes:

- Overall, there is general support for proposed improvements
- Participants support maintaining 2 lanes
- Participants support adding bike lanes
- Participants support turn lanes at Crumley and RR 12
- Participant noted concern for commercial traffic impacting residential nature of the road
- Participant noted concern for concert venue impacts
- Participants noted safety concerns at hairpin turn

Purpose



Identified through the 2016 Hays County Bond Program, the Fitzhugh Road Safety Study aims to identify near-term improvements that could be made within the existing County right-of-way along Fitzhugh Road from RM 12 to the Hays County Line. Funding for the design and construction of the near-term improvements is proposed in the 2024 Hays Road Bond package.

In summer 2024, the project team conducted a safety study throughout the project limits that included traffic counts, speed monitoring, signage and pavement analysis, and a review of crash data.


FITZHUGH ROAD CORRIDOR STUDY

Existing Conditions


Currently, Fitzhugh Road is a narrow, two-lane roadway that serves as a key east to west connector for many parts of Hays County. Throughout recent years, many businesses and residents have moved out to the area, increasing travelers along the corridor.

Current existing conditions and challenges of Fitzhugh Road include:


- Narrow lanes and shoulders
- Road surface conditions
- Limited visibility
- Limited infrastructure (lighting and sidewalks)

- Trautwein Road
- Pauls Valley Road
- Trail Driver Street



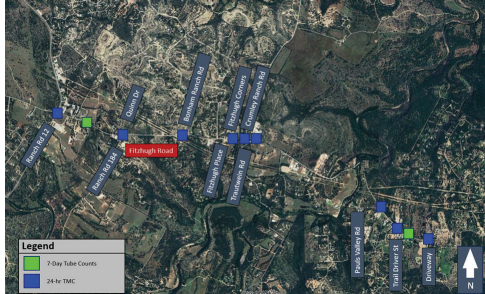
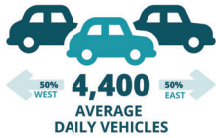
FITZHUGH ROAD CORRIDOR STUDY

Traffic Volumes

Data collection consisted of 24-hour Turning Movement Counts (TMCs) at study intersections and 7-day, 24-hour tube counts near RM 12 and Trail Driver St.

Average Daily Traffic

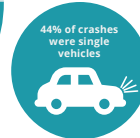
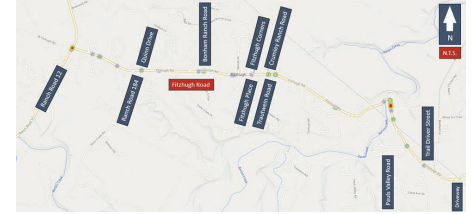
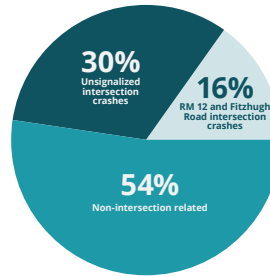
Average daily traffic along the corridor is approximately 4,400 vehicles, 50% eastbound 50% westbound



Data Collection Points

Crash Analysis

Throughout 2019 – 2023, **54 crashes** occurred along the corridor

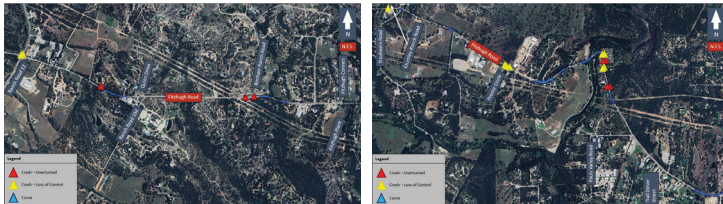


Crashes in the Fitzhugh Road corridor occurred disproportionately as single vehicle crashes in between intersections, or as single vehicle crashes at unsignalized intersections.

Crash Locations

The majority of loss of control and overturning crashes occurred at the following locations:

- Fitzhugh Road at RM 12
- Fitzhugh Road at Bonham Ranch Road
- Fitzhugh Road at Preslar Circle
- Eastern half of the hairpin curve between Preslar Circle and Pauls Valley Road



Proposed Near Term Improvements

INCREASE TRIANGLE SIGHT DISTANCE

- Trimming vegetation to improve intersection sight distance

INCREASE SPEED ENFORCEMENT

- Unsafe speeds are a problem throughout the corridor due to several sharp horizontal curves. At the study locations, the 85th percentile speed was 49 mph

Below are the proposed near-term improvements identified through the Safety Study. Funding for the design and construction of these improvements is proposed in the 2024 Hays County Road Bond.

INSTALL SHOULDERS WITH RUMBLE STRIPS

- Installation of shoulders with rumble strips on each side of the roadway

ADD RM 12 TURN LANES

- Add left turn lanes at RM 12 at Fitzhugh Road

INSTALL GUARDRAILS WITH DELINEATORS

- Guardrails in the vicinity of Fitzhugh Road at Bonham Ranch Road, Fitzhugh Road at Trautwein Road, Fitzhugh Road at Preslar Circle, and the hairpin curve

INSTALL RADAR SPEED LIMIT SIGNS, CHEVRON SIGNS, CURVE WARNING SIGNS, AND/OR SEQUENTIAL BEACONS

- Installation of additional curve warning signage and flashing beacons in advance of horizontal curves
- Radar speed limit signs that compare the speed of drivers to the posted speed limit

UPDATE PAVEMENT MARKINGS

- Pavement markings are in poor condition throughout corridor, often cracked or fading. Affected pavement markings include stop bars, edge lines, & centerlines

2024 Hays County Road Bond



Fitzhugh Road/CR 101 - Interim Safety Improvements and Corridor Study

Included in the 2024 Hays County Road Bond is the Fitzhugh Road/CR 101 project, which will propose \$5,000,000 for the design and construction of interim safety improvements and a corridor study along Fitzhugh Road from RM 12 to the Travis County line.

The corridor study will focus on operational and safety improvements for the 2-lane roadway and is anticipated to take place in spring 2025 through winter 2026.

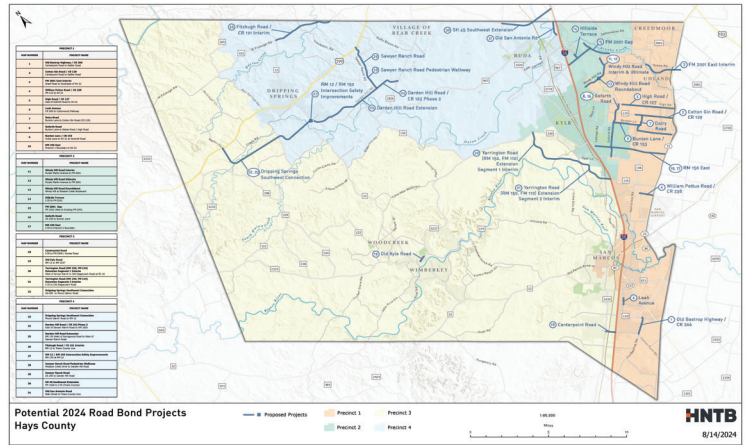

Fitzhugh has become increasingly used by commercial traffic as a way to bypass the numerous intersections between Fitzhugh Rd and RM12 on US290. It is an inappropriate route for heavy commercial traffic, due to all of the issues you have pointed out: road conditions, lack of shoulders, increasing residential traffic, lack of curve warnings and speed limits being exceeded. I would propose that you also add a weight limit for through traffic, if that is at all enforceable. I am also fearful of "creeping" | |

| | | | <p>improvements that would make Fitzhugh Rd a better commercial throughway. Fitzhugh should be regarded as a private residential and light commercial use roadway. No additional improvements that would drive additional commercial traffic should be considered. Fitzhugh Rd is a road that accommodates many smaller communities, schools, biking enthusiasts and small businesses. It also incorporates environmentally sensitive areas. Creeping improvements to Fitzhugh Rd that would make it a more suitable throughway (e.g., widening the road), especially during the anticipated limited access improvements to US290, will seriously endanger the environment and safety of the residents and small business owners. I am also going to make a logical leap to the proposed Fitzhugh Concert venue. If these improvements are being considered to guard the safety of the existing residents and businesses on the road, as I said previously, I am supportive. It's a dark road at night and a narrow road; speed limits should be enforced, curves should be evident. But, if there is any expectation that these interim improvements are expected to support the needs of the concert venue, you are wrong. If you are clocking over 4,000 cars per day, and seeing the current number of individual and multi-car crashes, adding an additional 2500 cars, in confined time intervals for events, is a silly proposition. We should be curtailing additional commercial traffic on Fitzhugh Rd, not improving it to support more. There is a perfectly good commercial traffic corridor in US290 that is being improved to allow for bypass of Dripping Springs in the near future. Seems like my address would be important relative to my proximity to and daily use of Fitzhugh Rd., if only to validate my invested interest in improving Fitzhugh Rd. *Agree that left turn lanes at the Fitzhugh Rd and RR12 intersection would be beneficial and perhaps nice to have but does little to improve safety on Fitzhugh Rd. The slight widening to enable right turns at the intersection would cost less, would alleviate congestion, and is long over due. * Crumley Ranch Rd vegetation management should be a priority. Visibility to traffic westbound from the Trautwein intersection is restricted and creates an unsafe condition. Further, turning right onto Fitzhugh Rd from Crumley Rd is difficult because of the deep bar ditch that has to be avoided while staying in the west bound lane when attention to accelerating traffic approaching from the Trautwein intersection is needed. Lastly, the entire 1/2 mile section of Crumley Rd within Hays county seems to stay in terrible condition with potholes that grow like weeds. The road needs widened and resurfaced. * I don't think rumble strips will improve safety at all. * More enforcement of the speed limits is needed. I was passed on Fitzhugh yesterday just west of Crumley Rd with oncoming traffic. Comments: I have no fundamental issue with improving Fitzhugh Rd for the safety of local residents and businesses. However, I think we should seriously consider whether Fitzhugh Rd is an appropriate throughway for heavy trucks and "non-resident commercial traffic" (traffic that does not have its origin or destination within the corridor from RM12 to US290). Fitzhugh has become increasingly used by commercial traffic as a way to bypass the numerous intersections between Fitzhugh Rd and RM12 on US290. It is an inappropriate route for heavy commercial traffic, due to all of the issues you have pointed out: road conditions, lack of shoulders, increasing residential traffic, lack of curve warnings and speed limits being exceeded. I would propose that you also add a weight limit for through traffic, if that is at all enforceable. I am also fearful of "creeping" improvements that would make Fitzhugh Rd a better commercial throughway. Fitzhugh should be regarded as a private residential and light commercial use roadway. No additional improvements that would drive additional commercial traffic should be considered. Fitzhugh Rd is a road that accommodates many smaller communities, schools, biking enthusiasts and small businesses. It also incorporates environmentally sensitive areas. Creeping improvements to Fitzhugh Rd that would make it a more suitable throughway (e.g., widening the road), especially during the anticipated limited access improvements to US290, will seriously endanger the environment and safety of the residents and small business owners. I am also going to make a logical leap to the proposed Fitzhugh Concert venue. If these improvements are being considered to guard the safety of the existing

residents and businesses on the road, as I said previously, I am supportive. It's a dark road at night and a narrow road; speed limits should be enforced, curves should be evident. But, if there is any expectation that these interim improvements are expected to support the needs of the concert venue, you are wrong. If you are clocking over 4,000 cars per day, and seeing the current number of individual and multi-car crashes, adding an additional 2500 cars, in confined time intervals for events, is a silly proposition. We should be curtailing additional commercial traffic on Fitzhugh Rd, not improving it to support more. There is a perfectly good commercial traffic corridor in US290 that is being improved to allow for bypass of Dripping Springs in the near future. Fitzhugh Rd should be as restricted as possible to local commercial traffic.

Comments: My residence is off Bonham Ranch Rd. I have lived in the area for 19 years. Seems like my address would be important relative to my proximity to and daily use of Fitzhugh Rd., if only to validate my invested interest in improving Fitzhugh Rd. *Agree that left turn lanes at the Fitzhugh Rd and RR12 intersection would be beneficial and perhaps nice to have but does little to improve safety on Fitzhugh Rd. The slight widening to enable right turns at the intersection would cost less, would alleviate congestion, and is long over due. * Crumley Ranch Rd vegetation management should be a priority. Visibility to traffic westbound from the Trautwein intersection is restricted and creates an unsafe condition. Further, turning right onto Fitzhugh Rd from Crumley Rd is difficult because of the deep bar ditch that has to be avoided while staying in the west bound lane when attention to accelerating traffic approaching from the Trautwein intersection is needed. Lastly, the entire 1/2 mile section of Crumley Rd within Hays county seems to stay in terrible condition with potholes that grow like weeds. The road needs widened and resurfaced. * I don't think rumble strips will improve safety at all. * More enforcement of the speed limits is needed. I was passed on Fitzhugh yesterday just west of Crumley Rd with oncoming traffic. I realize there are availability limitations to having patrol personnel and that it is a difficult task on a road with no shoulders. Increased visibility on the road or beside the road in the recent past has helped. Lastly, there was a 35 mph speed limit sign added a couple years ago about 50' east of the Bonham Ranch Rd intersection. The sign needs to be located further east, before the curve to have any positive result. The speed limit is already 35 mph coming from the west and no one that is

not making a left turn onto Bonham Ranch Rd is doing less than 50 mph. *Allowing tractor-trailer rigs onto Fitzhugh that cannot navigate the low water crossing at Barton Creek without stopping traffic in both lanes should be reconsidered. Perhaps an alternative route should be contemplated for that area that would be easier and safer to navigate.
