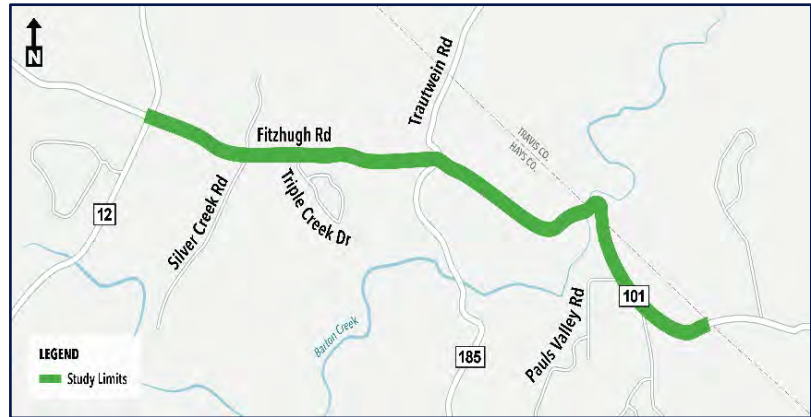


Fitzhugh Road Safety Study Public Involvement Summary

Project Overview

Hays County is planning for interim and long-term safety improvements along Fitzhugh Road from RM 12 to the Hays County line. The near-term improvements were based on a safety study conducted in the spring of 2024, as well as public input gathered in October 2024. The study included traffic counts, speed monitoring, signage and pavement analysis, and a review of crash data. The County is evaluating enhancements at identified high-crash areas such as Barton Creek Crossing and Fitzhugh Road at RM 12.



Property Owner Meetings

Hays County hosted individual meetings with property owners where additional right-of-way may be proposed for long-term improvements. The purpose of these meetings was to inform impacted property owners about the goals of the project, discuss property impacts, and review design considerations.

Meeting invites were mailed to three properties, and the project team met with all three of the potentially impacted property owners.

Open House Summary



Hays County hosted an Open House on Wednesday, Aug. 20, 2025, at Beerburg Event Center (13476 Fitzhugh Rd, Austin, TX 78736). Materials shared at the Open House were also available online at fitzhughsafetystudy.com, and a comment period was available from Wednesday, Aug. 20 through Friday, Sept. 5, 2025.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide updates on near-term safety improvements and offer an opportunity for community members to share feedback on potential upgrades at high-crash locations along Fitzhugh Road between RM 12 and the Hays County line. A survey was available at the Open House and online for participants to share their comments and ask questions. Roll plots of proposed improvements were available at the Open House for participants to share property specific comments.

Approximately 55 individuals, including Commissioner Walt Smith, attended the Open House. The project website received 239 views during the comment period and 52 comments.

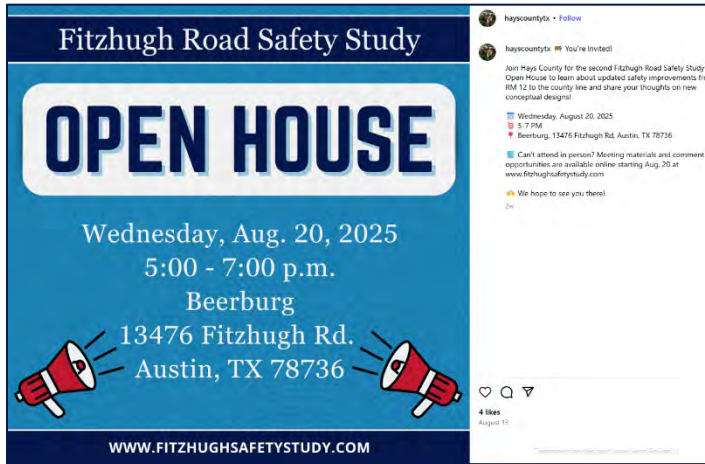

What We Heard

Open House comments were shared through several means including mapped comments, an online comment form, and in-person comment responses. The Open House received a total of 52 comments, and the key themes are identified below.

Key Themes:

General themes

- Commenters expressed support for maintaining cyclist accessibility on Fitzhugh Road through wide shoulders and not adding rumble strips.
- Most commenters expressed support for interim safety improvements.
- Many commenters expressed support for maintaining rural characteristics of the road, including keeping trees and maintaining Fitzhugh Road as a 2-lane road.
- Many commenters shared their concern for the long-term impact on private property.

RM 12 at Fitzhugh Redesign

- Most commenters expressed support for the design.

Fitzhugh Road at Trautwein Road

Scenario A

- Many commenters expressed support for this option, noting its sensibility and low-impact nature.
- Commenters who were opposed to this option noted drivers currently tend to drive through stop signs in the area.

Scenario B

- Fewer commenters expressed support for this option. They noted it appeared to be the least intrusive.
- Commenters opposed to this option preferred either Scenario A or C and felt this option was intrusive.

Scenario C

- Many commenters expressed support for this option due to its traffic-calming nature.
- Commenters who were opposed to this option noted that drivers in the area might not know how to properly use a roundabout and expressed concern about its impact to private property.

Barton Creek Crossing

- Many commenters shared that both scenarios would intrude on private property, including houses, a ranch, and a family cemetery. These commenters expressed support for a new bridge over the Barton Creek Crossing.

Project Overview



Hays County is planning improvements to Fitzhugh Road from RM 12 to the Hays County line to enhance safety and mobility. Funded through the Hays County Transportation Department, these improvements were shaped by a 2024 safety study and community feedback from the October 2024 public meeting. The County is also evaluating potential improvements at high-crash locations like the Barton Creek crossing and other key intersections.

Safety Study Overview



Since the last Open House in summer 2024, the County and project team have been working to advance the proposed safety improvements. The Safety Study found:

With **4,400 average daily travelers**, Fitzhugh Road faces challenges such as:

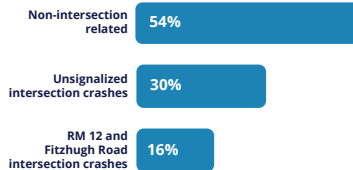
Narrow lanes and shoulders, pavement deterioration



Sight line obstructions



Throughout 2019 – 2023, **54 crashes occurred** along the corridor



Based on this information, safety improvements were developed to meet the immediate needs of the corridor.

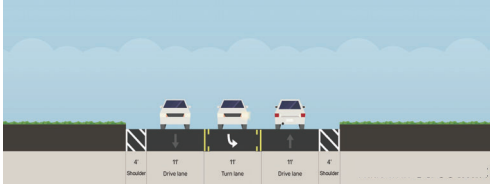

Below are possible roadway configurations at identified intersections and along Fitzhugh Road.

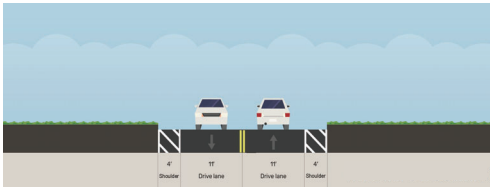
Potential Intersection Improvements

Potential Roadway Improvements

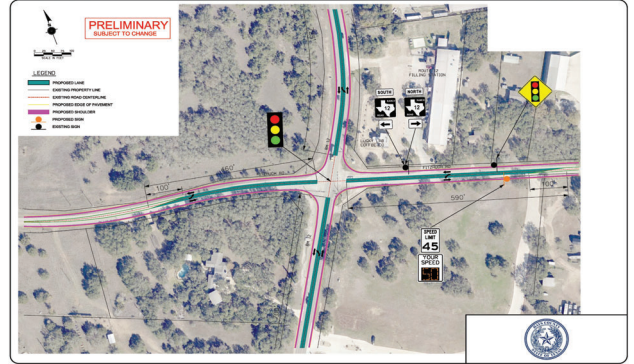

RM 12 at Fitzhugh Road Intersection



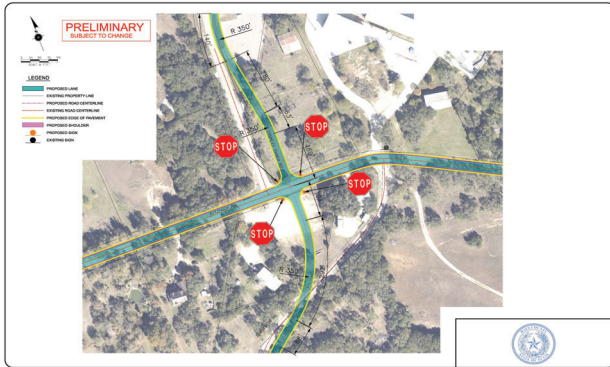

Trautwein Road at Fitzhugh Road - Scenario A



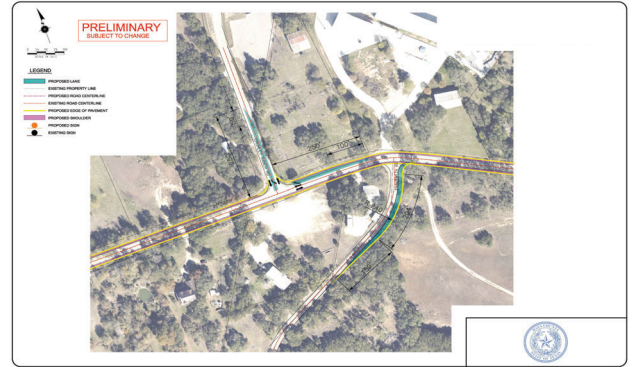

Trautwein Road at Fitzhugh Road - Scenario B



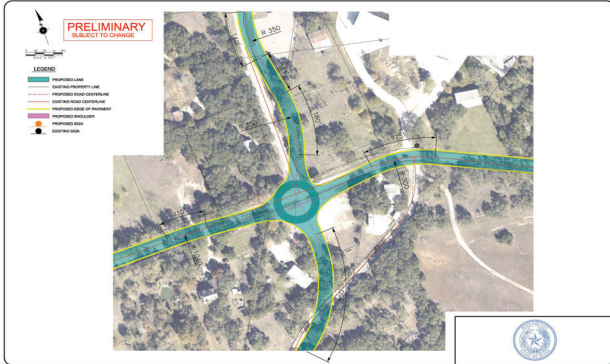

Trautwein Road at Fitzhugh Road – Scenario C



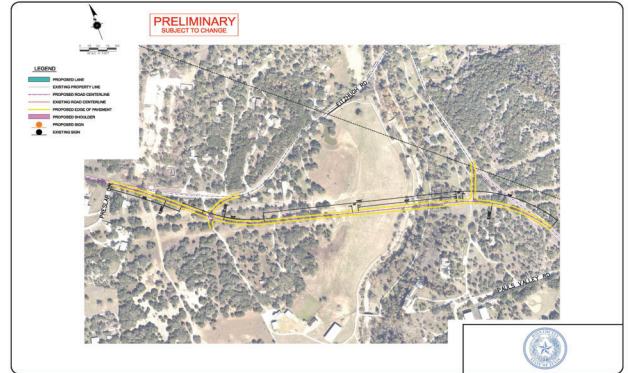

Barton Creek Crossing – Scenario A



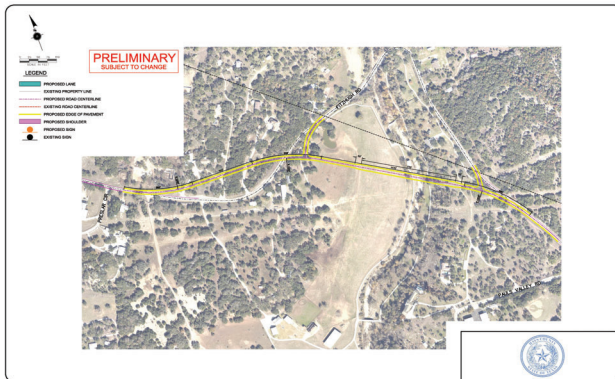
